Call to Order Regular Monthly Meeting was called to order by Chairman Wermerskirchen at 7:00 PM; Pledge of Allegiance said.

Minutes On a motion by Nytes/Wermerskirchen the February Regular Monthly Meeting Minutes were approved as presented; carried 2:0:0 (Deutsch absent).

Snow Removal

- Officers discussed recent communication related to 240th Street West snow removal. Preusser contacted the
 township after their bituminous surface was damaged. The officers reviewed the road ROW and easement for the
 turnaround. The blade must be lifted to get through the gate. The turnaround is firming up but it was very soft in
 2019. Johnson is trying his best to plow snow and turn around within the limited space. Perkins will communicate
 with the Preusser's.
- 2. The curve right sign on Naylor needs to be re-erected.
- 3. The Stop Ahead sign is missing by the railroad track on 245th
- 4. The newly planted grass in RSP2/3 may have received some damage during plowing; Perkins will view
- 5. The Lano mailbox on St. Benedict Road needs to be straightened
- 6. Johnson will provide a quote for hauling; will increase from Bryan Rock due to bridge work detours

Road Overseer Report

- 1. Perkins was able to add RSP2/3 seal coating to the county's projects
- 2. A resident on Baseline complained the snow plow driver is throwing snow too far into his yard
- 3. Cones were place on Naylor and will remain until the sign is replaced
- 4. The mailbox at 24940 WCLD was repaired by Johnson
- 5. 742 SMB needs a mailbox post (Hanzel Construction)
- 6. WCLD has terrible potholes and they will be filled as soon as weather allows
- 7. Perkins will check if the county can do patching on WCLD/Juniper; otherwise the potholes will be cold patched
