# Helena Township Board of Supervisors Regular Monthly Meeting

#### Minutes of November 7, 2019 | New Prague Fire Conference Center

Call to Order Regular Monthly Meeting was called to order by Chairman Nytes at 7:00 PM; Pledge of Allegiance said.

- Officers Chairman Ed Nytes, Supervisors John Wermerskirchen and Duane Deutsch, Treasurer Nathan Hutton, Road Overseer Present Darryl Perkins and Clerk DeAnn Croatt.
- Others Jeff Klehr, Rev. Steve Trewartha

#### Minutes On a motion by Deutsch/Wermerskirchen the October Regular Monthly Meeting and the Work Shop Minutes were approved as presented; carried unanimously.

FaithPoint Pastor Steve Trewartha attended the meeting on behalf of FaithPoint Lutheran Church. The church wishes to apply for a CUP allowing them to build a church in Section 35 of Helena Township. Originally, the church was scheduled for a hearing with Scott County on December 9, 2019; however subsequently Scott County determined the hearing is with the New Prague Orderly Annexation Board (two township/two city/one county) and will be held early to mid-December.

> The church will be at the intersection of 270<sup>th</sup> Street West (township road) and Redwing Avenue (Scott County Road 89). The church's engineer, Greg Halling, prepared the plans. It is their intent to break ground early spring 2020.

Background notes:

- The church received a favorable township recommendation to build a church on 14 acres in Section 35 September 3, 2015; subject to road improvement issues approved
- The DRT meeting was February 15, 2017; at that time plans were very conceptual.
- The county said all driveways must come off the township road; as a result, the township requested 270<sup>th</sup> Street West be improved to a bituminous surface. Engineer Halling included this in his specifications.
- The township received escrow funds and will involve the township's Engineer Andrew Vistad and Attorney Bob Ruppe

The township will continue the discussion at a Work Shop on November 20, 2019 and requested the following information prior to that date:

- Engineer Vistad will review the plans from Engineer Halling, contact him with any concerns or question, and provide the township with an estimated cost to improve 270<sup>th</sup> Street West along the north property line.
- Attorney Ruppe will draft a developer's agreement and send to the township.
  - The township received \$5k escrow from FaithPoint; asked Ruppe to ensure this amount is sufficient
  - The timing of the road improvements will be after the heavy equipment work has been completed
  - Will determine if a performance bond, surety, letter of credit or some other form is needed, the amount 0 and the form to ensure the township does not bear the cost of the road improvements

Rev. Trewartha will be copied on communication and will receive copies of invoices as escrow funds are spent. When escrow funds are depleted, the township will request additional money.

Maintenance People are getting stuck on 240<sup>th</sup> off Xanadu was reported to Deutsch; Klehr will haul gravel and grade it well

### **Old Business**

225<sup>th</sup> St W The reimbursement funds were received.

**RSP2/3** Fred Simon expressed disappointment that bigger stones were not removed from his driveway prior to the new gravel application. Second notices for unpaid mailbox posts will be sent by the Clerk on November 8, 2019.

> Resolution 110719 to "Adopt a Property Tax Schedule for the Raven Stream Plats Two and Three Reconstruction Project" was adopted on a motion by Deutsch/Wermerskirchen; carried unanimously. \$88k has been paid; \$88k will be accessed for collection with property taxes 2020-2029 at 6 percent interest.

Townline Clerk was notified by Cedar Lake Clerk Speltz that the Cedar Lake Board of Supervisors approved the "Agreement for Road the Division of Maintenance Responsibilities for Baseline Avenue and Baseline Blvd, both being a Town Line Road Agreement between Cedar Lake Township and Helena Township, Scott County, Minnesota" without changes to the draft proposed by Helena Township.

> On a motion by Wermerskirchen/Nytes the agreement was adopted; carried 2:1:0 (Deutsch). A signed original will be recorded and a copy will be returned to Cedar Lake Township with the payment for 2020.

SWCD The township asked SWCD to erect signage, at the west end of the access road in Hunters Ridge, so people/hunters don't drive on it, i.e., "No Trespassing", or "No Entrance", or something similar.

Streambank SWCD is stabilizing the creek bank south of 220th and east of Xanadu in Helena Township. This site was identified in Stabilization a feasibility study because of the high sediment produced. No costs will be borne by the township.
